**Schedule C**  
**Seaside Interfaith Chapel**

Regulations for Usage

- A. The Seaside Chapel requires a cleaning before and after each scheduled event. Please allow at least a two-hour time frame before event.
- B. If removal of altar items is requested, including the sandstone/shell cross, or 4 wooden chairs, ONLY the staff of the Chapel may remove, store and, after the service, reposition them. No others should handle or move these items. The American flag, 2 pewter candlesticks and the wooden podium may be moved or removed but a representative of HOCO must handle all movement and all items must be returned to their proper location immediately after each event. The altar may not be moved.
- C. Depending on the events in Seaside, a parking/transportation plan may be required for Chapel event.
- D. Passenger vehicles of 25-29 passengers are allowed in Seaside, no larger.
- E. In accordance with the Seaside Interfaith Chapel by-laws, same sex marriages are not permitted in the Chapel nor on its grounds.
- F. Marriages outside the Christian (all denominations) and Jewish faiths may not be performed as defined by the Seaside Interfaith Chapel Board of Directors.
- G. HOCO Management Staff must be on site for all weddings, meetings or special events unless independently contracted by BOD.
- H. The addition of staples, nails, hooks, etc. are not allowed. Only 3M Command strips may be used (no other brand). Florists may use the existing hardware that is pre-placed and permanent in the Seaside Chapel, however there is to be no draping of anything over the scones on the wall.
- I. Aisle runners are prohibited.
- J. Food and Beverage (excluding water) are prohibited.
- K. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited inside the Chapel!
- L. An individual designated by Chapel BOD must operate the in-house chapel sound system.
- M. Fire code allows for no more than 200 guests in the Chapel.
- N. Amplified music is prohibited on the Seaside Chapel grounds to include the lawn and courtyard.
- O. Upstairs guest seating is not available as the musicians and photographers occupy the space.
- P. The use of lit candles is prohibited in the 8 scones on the walls.
- Q. Only white or cream live petals may be used when being dropped on the floors inside.
- R. Bubbles or live flower petals to toss may be used outside on the Chapel lawn.
- S. We strongly encourage the use of the Seaside minister for all wedding ceremonies
- T. Floral arrangements left for our Sunday services are very much appreciated.
